



INSPIRING STORIES

Members of Oswestry Rugby Club were shocked when they heard that two of the mums involved in the club, Liz and Teresa, had been diagnosed with breast cancer. They were especially shocked as the president had recently been diagnosed with prostate cancer too.

They decided to rally around and organise an Ironman fundraiser for both breast and prostate cancer. Stewart Johnson, Liz's husband was one of the instigators of the fundraiser. "Once we all got together and shared stories, we realised how many of us had been touched by cancer and how close this disease is to most of us," he said.

And being a rugby club, in true sporting fashion, they decided to get competitive and set up two teams – one each for breast and prostate cancer – challenging each other to see who can raise the most money whilst also raising awareness.

Players, parents, and family members of the Oswestry rugby club trained hard to compete in the Ironman challenge and smashed their £15,000 target raising over an incredible £21,000 for Breast Cancer UK.

WHAT AN AMAZING EFFORT!



Kathryn from Worcestershire raised over £320 by running 100 miles in a month, she was inspired to fundraise after her best friend was diagnosed with breast cancer.

Florence and Evelyn from Hampshire decided to bake some cakes to sell to their friends and family. The two young sisters raised £130.

Friends Clare and Clare from Staffordshire raised over £3000 by both doing tandem skydives.

FUNDRAISING TIPS

Set up your fundraising page



- Click on the fundraise for us button and follow the simple instructions to get your fundraising off the ground.
- Make sure you set a fundraising target as this can encourage people to support you and help smash your target!
- If you choose to collect your donations in person, use the sponsorship form attached to make sure you collect your supporters gift aid details.

Share your fundraising



- Share your fundraising page with your friends, family and colleagues through your social media channels, WhatsApp groups and emails.
- A good time to share your fundraiser is on pay day, usually at the end of the month!
- Add photos and updates to your fundraising page to make it inspiring and share regular updates on your progress with your family and friends.
- Tag us and include #BreastCancerUK in your social media posts.
- Think about who you know. For example, do you know any local media or social groups that you can share your challenge with?


